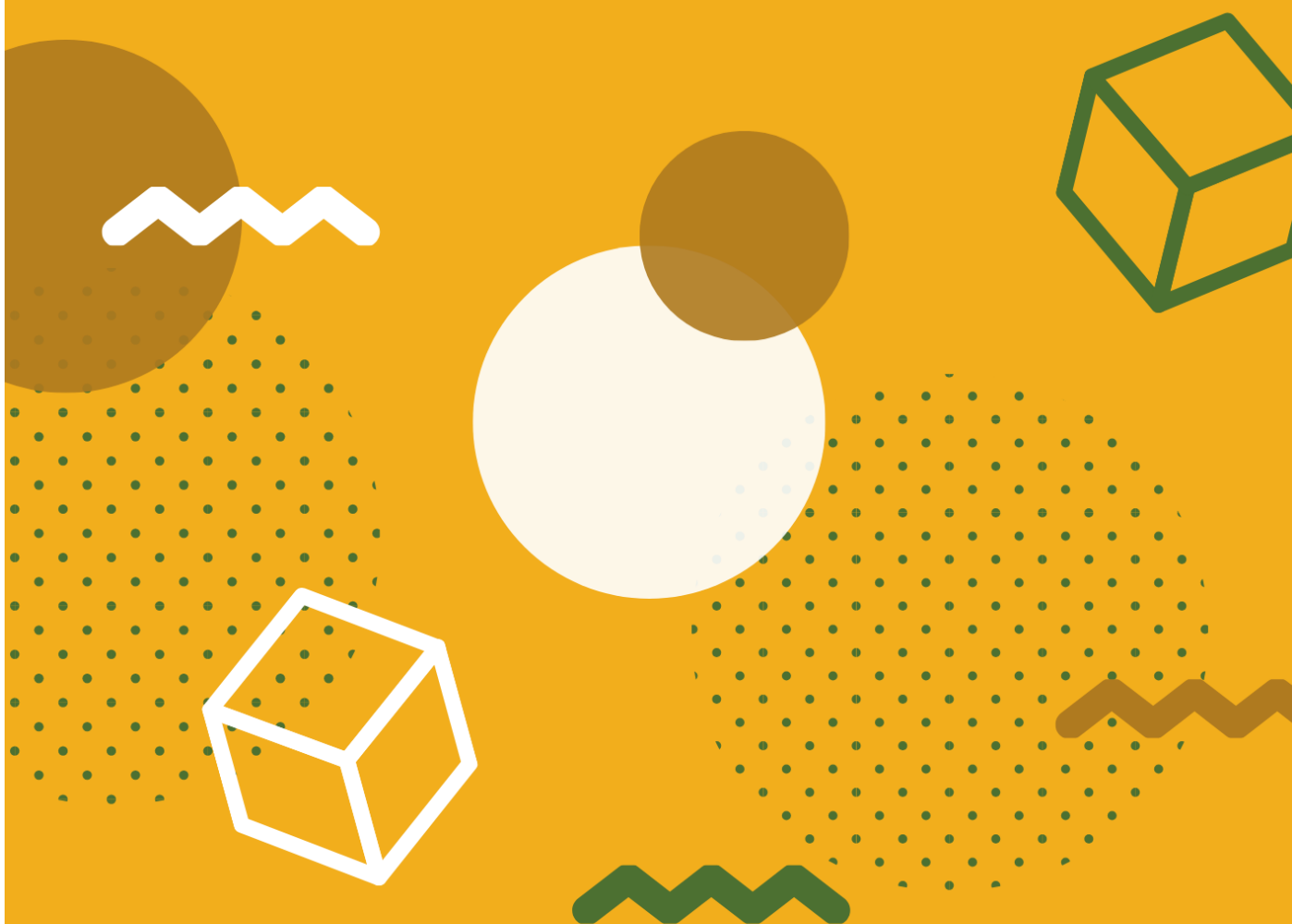

TRAVEL

1. By air

[Belgium's international airport](#) is situated in Zaventem, on the outskirts of Brussels. From Brussels Airport, you can travel to Ghent [by train](#) to Gent-Sint-Pieters (€14,10). You can also fly to [Brussels-Charleroi](#) and travel to Ghent by a [flibcobus](#) (€20-25) Once arrived at Gent-Sint-Pieters, you can get a tram or bus to your accommodation. 2. By train

You can travel by high-speed train (Eurostar) to Brussels from London, Amsterdam, Rotterdam, Köln

More international trains? Go to [SNCB Europe](#), [Voyages SNCF](#), [European Rail Guide](#), [InterRail](#). From Brussels, you can travel to Ghent [by train](#) to Gent-Sint-Pieters (€14,10).

3. By car

If you decide to come by car, you will find Ghent at the crossroads of two large motorways: E17 and E40. Ghent's city centre is a pedestrian zone, so no cars are allowed. Parking is free outside Ghent. You can take the tram to get into the centre.
