Congress Information and Schedule

Day 1 - May 15, 2024

Welcome & Registration (11:30 – 13:00)

The welcome reception and registration will take place in the atrium of the Suglio Business Center (Ground Floor). Clear directional signs will be available throughout the venue to guide attendees to the registration area. Catering by 1908 will provide a standing aperitif-style lunch in the same atrium. Attendees will receive their badge and merchandising bag during registration.

Opening & Congress Sessions

Following the welcome session, the congress sessions will begin. Attendees will participate in discussions, workshops, and presentations throughout the afternoon.

Coffee Break (15:30 - 16:00)

A short break will be provided with coffee and refreshments.

Evening Program – Dinner in Lugano (starting from 20:00)

The day will conclude with a standing dinner in Lugano, offering guests an opportunity to explore the city's charming streets before heading back to their hotels.

Day 2 - May 16, 2024

Opening & Congress Session

Following a quick welcoming time, the second congress sessions will begin. Attendees will partecipate in more discussions, workshops and presentation throughout the afternoon.

Coffee Break (10:45 - 11:15)

A mid-morning break with coffee and refreshments will be available for attendees.

Farewell Lunch (13:00 – 14:00)

A final lunch will be offered before the closing of the congress. Attendees will have the option to dine together or choose a takeaway lunch for convenience.

Routes

The closest airports are **Milano Malpensa (MXP)** and **Zürich (ZRH)**. Lugano has its own train station right in the center of the city, which offers a quick connection to Lamone Cadempino train station near Manno, where the Symposium will take place.

From Milan Malpensa Airport (MXP) to Lugano

By Train

Take the Malpensa Express from Malpensa Airport to Milano Centrale (about 50 min). From Milano Centrale, take an EuroCity or regional train to Lugano (about 1h).

By Bus

Take Bus **445-Lamone Stazione** to the bus stop "Manno, Suglio" or Bus **TPL 5-Manno** to the bus stop "Manno, Uovo di Manno".

Parking options in Manno are limited. If you plan to arrive by car, please inform us in advance so we can reserve a parking spot at the **Suglio Business Center**. The Suglio Business Center is just out of the "Lugano Nord" A2 highway exit in Manno. Useful navigation apps to reach "SUPSI Manno, Lugano" can be **Google Maps** or **Waze**.
